

APPLE'S PATENT CLAIMS

Apple's claims on infringements made by Samsung in their various mobile and tablet devices are categorised in three distinct groups. Below are some highlights in each of the category:

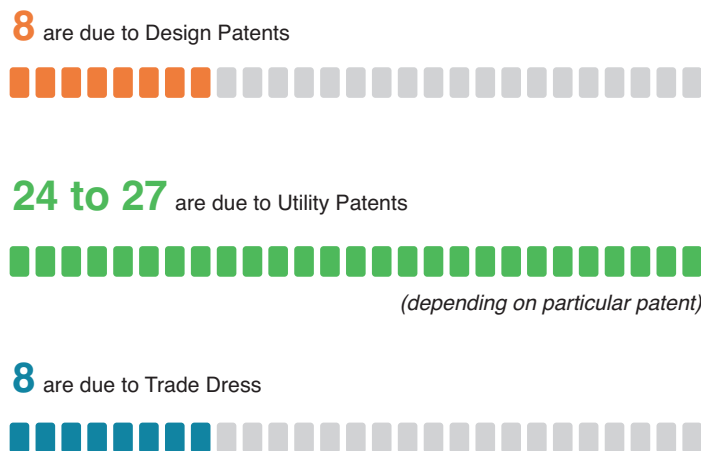
